STEP 1: DOWNLOAD



Search for READsquared in the Apple or Google Play Store and Click Get or Install

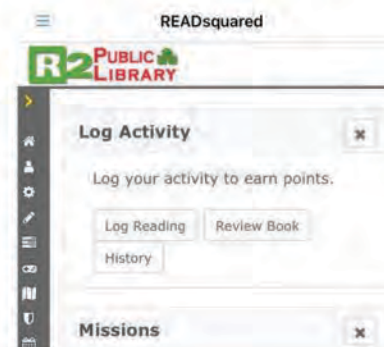


STEP 2: FIND YOUR LIBRARY

Type your library name in and select it from the list

STEP 3: LOGIN/REGISTER

Login if you already have a READsquared account or register.



STEP 4: LOG YOUR READING

Your data transfers seamlessly between the desktop program and app

HOW TO LOG YOUR READING

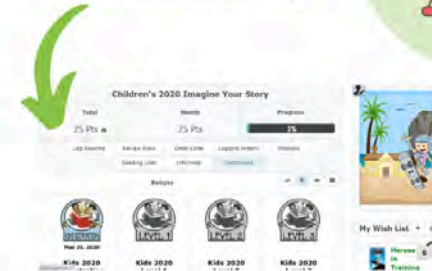


STEP 1: CREATE YOUR ACCOUNT

Adults can register themselves, or themselves and children, or just children. Children can register too (some libraries require parent permission).

STEP 2: READ

Read those books! Some libraries track number of books, some track time spent reading. Whichever your library asks for, you can log reading on your home page.

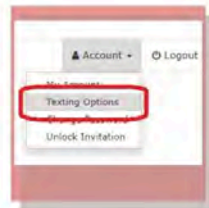


SIGN UP FOR TEXT REMINDERS

Get important reading program messages and reminders sent from your library to your phone.

STEP 1: ENABLE TEXTING IN YOUR ACCOUNT SETTINGS

From your READsquared home page click Account > Texting Options



STEP 2: ENTER YOUR DETAILS

Click YES and enter your cell provider and phone number.

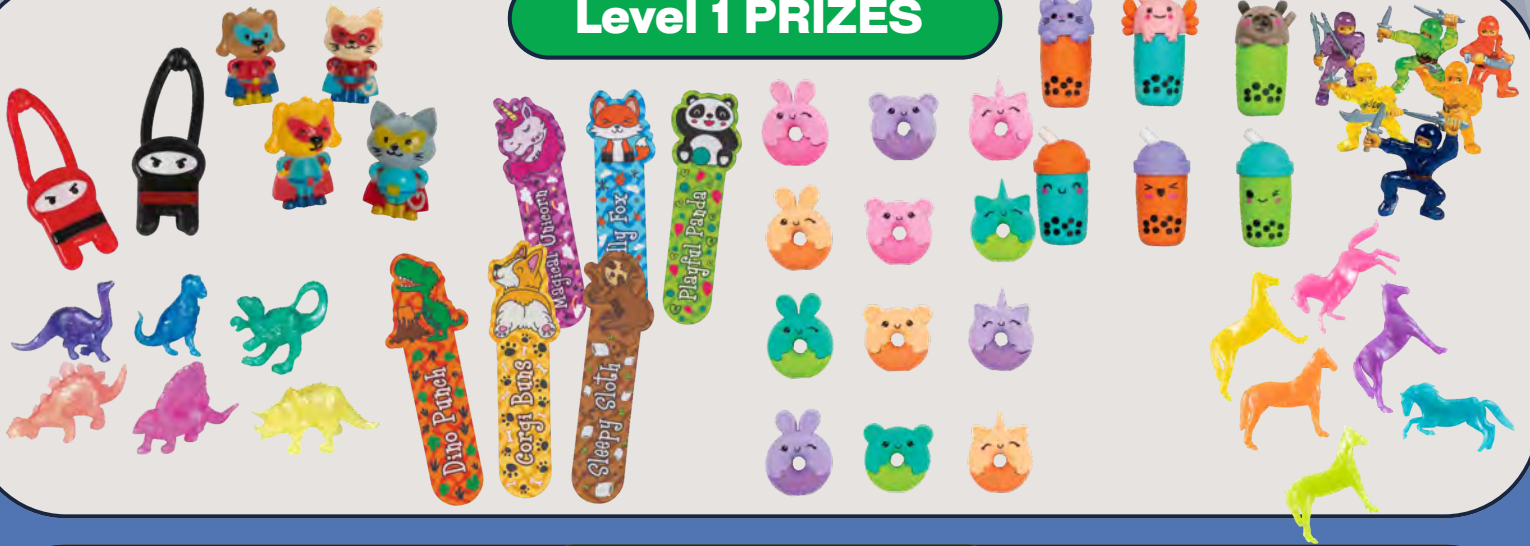
